



Our Laboratory

Our laboratory is equipped with the most modern, standard and sophisticated equipments with state-of-the-art facilities. A total number of 18 labs include 4 pharmaceutical chemistry labs, 4 pharmaceutics labs, 3 pharmacology labs, 1 pharmacognosy lab, 1 pharmacy practice lab, 1



machine room and 1 central instrumentation room ensuring our students achieve the best of practical knowledge with highly-qualified guidance.

Computer Lab

The college has a wellequipped computer laboratory containing a sufficient number of computers with LAN and internet services as well as printers; Software's to learn basic computer applications, English communications and



computer application in pharmacy including experimental pharmacology skills.

Library



Yoga

Yoga is a group of physical, mental, and spiritual practices or disciplines which originated in ancient India. There is a broad variety of Yoga schools, practices, and goalsin Hinduism, Buddhism, and Jainism. Among the most well-known types of yoga are Hatha yoga and Rāja yoga.

The origins of yoga have been speculated to date back to pre-VedicIndian traditions, it is mentioned in the Rigveda, but most likely developed around the sixth and fifth centuries BCE, in ancient India's ascetic and śramaṇa movements. The chronology of earliest texts describing yoga-practices is unclear, varyingly credited to Hindu Upanishads and Buddhist Pāli Canon probably of third century BCE or later. The Yoga Sutras of Patanjali date from the first half of the 1st millennium CE, but only gained prominence in the West in the 20th century Hatha yoga texts emerged around the 11th century with origins in tantra.

Yoga gurus from India later introduced yoga to the west, following the success of Swami Vivekananda in the late 19th and early 20th century In the 1980s, yoga became popular as a system of physical exercise across the Western world. Yoga in Indian traditions, however, is more than physical exercise; it has a meditative and spiritual core One of the six major orthodox schools of Hinduism is also called which Yoga, has its own epistemology and metaphysics, and is closely related to Hindu Samkhya philosophy.

Many studies have tried to determine the effectiveness of yoga as a complementary intervention for cancer, schizophrenia,



asthma, and heart disease. The results of these studies have been mixed inconclusive. with cancer studies suggesting none to unclear effectiveness, and others suggesting yoga may reduce risk factors and aid in a patient's psychological healing process. December 1, 2016, Yoga was listed as UNESCO's Intangible cultural heritage.












Seminar

Workshops






Career Guidance

The article is about world most expensive drug, Zolgensma- Onasemnogene abeparvovec- a rare drug for rare disease (SMA-Spinal Muscular Atrophy)used for genetherapy and the cost is around 16 crores. These breakthroughs present a big challenge-how do you value and pay for a one time therapy that provides a lifetime benefits to the patients.

INTRODUCTION:

Zolgensma was developed by the Swiss drugmaker NOVARTIS in 2018 to treat Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA). It is made up of a new working SMN(Survival Motor Neuron) Gene. Zolgensma is a gene therapy approved by the US FDA

WHAT IS SMA?

Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA) is a group of hereditary diseases that progressively destroys motor neurons.

Destruction of motor neurons leads to muscle weakness and atrophy (decrease in size or wasting of body tissue or organ)

TREATMENT

This involves replacing the problem SMN1 gene
It is used for children under 2 years
Route of administration is through IV infusion
DOSE-5.5ml for ONE TIME TREATMENT

WHY ZOLGENSMA IS SO EXPENSIVE?

It costs roughly around 16 crores in INR

"This deal is a life changer for youngsters with this cruel disease and for their families" said NHS England chief executive Sir Simon Stevens





NEW DRUG PROFILE

What is Agamree?

Definition: Agamree (vamorolone) is novelcorticosteroid used to treat Duchennemuscular dystrophy (DMD) to improve motor function with a potential of reduction in adverse events such as health, growth rate, bone and behavior.

Uses :Agamree has antiinflammatory and immunosuppressive effects that work (mechanism of action) through the glucocorticoid receptor, although the exact way it works for DMD is unknown.

Dosinginformation: The usual Agamree dosage: 6 mg/kg taken orally once daily, preferably with a meal, up to a maximum daily dosage of 300 mg for patients weighing more than 50 kg.

Interactions: Other drugs may affect Agamree, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal products. Tell your doctor about all your current medicines and any medicine you start or stop using.

Tell your doctor if taking itraconazole, a strong CYP3A4 inhibitor, as the drug interaction will increase Agamree levels.

Side effects: The most common Agamree side effects are cushingoid features, psychiatric disorders, vomitin g, weight gain, and vitamin D deficiency, these side effects affected more than 10% of patients and more than the placebo group.

What is Jaypirca?

Definition: Jaypirca is a prescription medicine used to treat adults with mantle cell lymphoma (MCL).

Jaypirca belongs to the class of drugs called Bruton's tyrosine kinase (BTK) inhibitors. BTK is a molecular target found across numerous B-cell leukemias and lymphomas including mantle cell lymphoma.

Uses: Jaypirca is used to treat adults with mantle cell lymphoma (MCL) that has come back (relapsed) or did not respond to previous treatment (refractory), and who have already received two or more treatments for their cancer, including a covalent Bruton tyrosine kinase (BTK) inhibitor medicine.

Dose: 200 mg orally once daily

- ➤ Take Jaypirca tablets exactly as your healthcare provider tells you.
- ➤ Do not change your dose or stop treatment unless your healthcare provider tells you to do so.

Take the tablets one time each day at about the same time each day.

Interactions: Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescription and overthe-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbal supplements. Taking Jaypirca with certain other medicines may affect how Jaypirca or the other medicines work and can cause side effects.

Jaypirca may also interact with grapefruit juice, though the effect varies widely among brands.

Side effects:

- ➤ Infections can happen during treatment with Jaypirca.
- ➤ Bleeding problems (hemorrhage) can happen during treatment with Jaypirca and can be serious and may lead to death.
- ➤ Decrease in blood cell counts
- ➤ Heart rhythm problems (atrial fibrillation and atrial flutter) have happened in people treated with Jaypirca
- > Second primary cancers
